



## Technical Product Update 200901

Re: Garmin NMEA 2000 Cables

Date: June 30, 2009

It has come to the attention of the National Marine Electronic Association that some older Garmin cables that were marketed as NMEA 2000 Certified should not have been.

Garmin has assured NMEA that these older cables and are no longer being sold by Garmin.

To alleviate any confusion with older Garmin NMEA 2000 cables, the following cable designation is the only Garmin NMEA 2000 Approved cable.

The designated cable will have a wrapped part number on one end with the number 320-xxx-xxx that looks like this:



There should also be a fire resistant designator of "Ft 4" stamped on the cable.

Garmin has submitted test results of these cables for approval by NMEA. NMEA has verified the test results of this cable. NMEA has approved these Garmin cables only as "NMEA 2000 Approved."
