The NMEA CMET renewal period is five years from the date of issue. CMETS who successfully complete three renewal exams (one at their 5 year anniversary, again at their 10 year anniversary, and again at their 15 year anniversary) automatically achieve Lifetime CMET status upon passing their third and final renewal test. The only other requirement is this individual is still active in the Marine Electronics Industry.

For those CMETS who have expired within a 2 year grace period, they may renew by taking a 50 question on-line test and pay the standard renewal fee of \$50 for NMEA members and \$100 for non-members.

Once payment is received at the NMEA office, staff will email a link to take the on-line test.

Once completed the on-line test, the testing program will automatically email the test results to the NMEA office, in which NMEA staff can verify the student's grade, then print and mail a new CMET certificate.
