



NMEA Certification Renewal Process

MEI, NMEA 2000, AMEI, and Advanced NMEA 2000

The NMEA MEI, NMEA 2000, AMEI, and Advanced NMEA 2000 renewal period is three years from the date of issue. There is a two-year grace period which a renewal can remain qualified for renewal.

For those who have expired within a 2-year grace period, they may renew by taking a 50-question on-line test and pay the standard renewal fee of \$50/members or \$100 non-members. Once payment is received at the NMEA office, staff will email a link with updated course materials which also contains the on-line test. This link (containing the course materials and test) will expire 30 days after it is sent from the NMEA National Office, so it is important that all renewals get completed within this 30-day window.

Once completed the on-line test, the testing program will automatically email the test results to the NMEA office, in which NMEA staff can verify the student's grade, then print and mail a new certificate which will be in effect for three years from the date of issue.

CMET / NMET

The NMEA CMET / NMET renewal period is five years from the date of issue. CMETs and NMETs who successfully complete three renewal exams (one at their 5-year anniversary, again at their 10-year anniversary, and again at their 15-year anniversary) automatically achieve Lifetime CMET / NMET status upon passing their third and final renewal test. The only other requirement is this individual is still active in the Marine Electronics Industry.

For those CMETs / NMETs who have expired within a 2-year grace period, they may renew by taking a 50-question on-line test with 1 hour time limit and pay the standard renewal fee of \$50.

Once payment is received at the NMEA office, staff will email a link to take the on-line test.

Once completed the on-line test, the testing program will automatically email the test results to the NMEA office, in which NMEA staff can verify the student's grade, then print and mail a new CMET / NMET certificate.

Over 2 years expired for all NMEA Certificates

For those who have had their NMEA certifications (CMET, NMET, AMEI, MEI, NMEA 2000 and Advanced NMEA 2000) expired for more than 2 years, they must re-take the appropriate full training and full exam but can do so with a 50% discount. Examples are as follows:

Classroom

MEI, NMEA 2000, AMEI course fee for NMEA members is \$450, 50% discount \$225.

MEI, NMEA 2000, AMEI course fee for non-members \$650, 50% discount \$325.

Advanced NMEA 2000 course fee for members \$650, 50% discount \$325

Advanced NMEA 2000 course fee for non-members \$850, 50% discount \$425

Proctored Test

CMET / NMET test fee for NMEA members is \$100, 50% discount \$50.

CMET / NMET test fee for NMEA non-members is \$300, 50% discount \$150.
